### Extracurricular Activities for Summer 2020

**Swimming lessons** will be offered to students age 3 and above. Classes are provided by Southwestern Aquatics Team ([www.swimwithswat.org](http://www.swimwithswat.org)) at the Don Cook FBISD Natatorium behind Walden. Class sizes are limited due to ages and small ratios. Generally sessions are for 2 week periods (Monday—Thursday).

**Gymnastics classes** will be offered to students age 3 and above through Sugar Land Gymnastics (building connected to our playground). Class sizes are limited due to age groups. Walden students attend gymnastics classes with Walden teachers on a set day of the week and time.

**Taekwondo** will be offered to students ages 4 and above here at Walden. The class is instructed by Jenny Pless, black belt master. Class sizes are arranged by age groups. Class will be on Mondays in the afternoons.
